By boat

Visitors can reach Penghu by boat, with service from Budai Harbor in Chiayi City, and the Port of Kaohsiung. Mainland Chinese visitors can sail from Xiamen to Kinmen and then continue by boat to Penghu, or they can take a charter flight directly from Xiamen to Penghu.

By plane

It is easy to get to Penghu from other parts of Taiwan. Regular flights serve the islands from Taipei, Taichung, Tainan, Chiayi, and Kaohsiung, and a regular charter flight service is offered from Kinmen. Another option is to fly to the main island of Taiwan from one of the various cities offering direct cross-strait service and then continue by plane or boat to Penghu to round out the Formosan tour. Flights to Magong are available from Taipei Songshan Airport and Kaohsiung International Airport.

There are three main airports in Taiwan:

Taipei Songshan Airport (TSA)

In Taipei City, the capital city of Taiwan
International flights are from Japan and China
Several flights from TSA to Magong Airport (MZG) everyday

Kaohsiung International Airport (KHH)

In Kaohsiung City located in southern Taiwan
Several flights from KHH to Magong Airport (MZG) everyday

Taoyuan International Airport (TPE)

In Taoyuan, near to the capital city, Taipei
Take shuttle bus from TPE to TSA in 45 minutes
